A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE SECOND FIVE-YEAR
IMPLEMENTATION PLAN FOR THE NAVAL TRAINING CENTER
REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego [Agency] is engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan for the Naval Training Center Redevelopment Project Area [the Project Area]; and

WHEREAS, California Community Redevelopment Law (California Health and Safety Code sections 33000–34009) [Redevelopment Law] requires the preparation and approval of an implementation plan at the time of adoption of the Redevelopment Plan, and subsequent implementation plans each five years thereafter, which may be amended as necessary; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Redevelopment Law, the implementation plan must describe specific goals and objectives, proposed projects, a program of actions and expenditures proposed to be made within the five years of the implementation plan, and a description of how the proposed projects will improve or alleviate blighting conditions in the Project Area; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2739 adopted on April 29, 1997, the Agency approved

the Naval Training Center Redevelopment Plan and First Five-Year Implementation Plan; NOW
THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego, that the
Second Implementation Plan for the Naval Training Center Redevelopment Project is approved.
