A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURE OF \$415,000 TOWARDS THE CITY'S REHABILITATION OF DAYS INN MOTEL, TO BE USED AS A SHORT-TERM TRANSITIONAL HOUSING FACILITY FOR HOMELESS FAMILIES, AND AMENDING THE HOUSING COMMISSION'S FY01 BUDGET TO INCORPORATE \$137,786 OF HOUSING TRUST FUNDS REDEVELOPMENT CARRYOVER FUNDS

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego desires to house homeless families in a service- enriched environment which encourages transition away from homelessness; and

WHEREAS, the City has been seeking a facility that could provide the desired environment; and

WHEREAS, the City has an opportunity to purchase the Days Inn Motel property, located in the Centre City area, and adapt it for use as a short-term transitional housing facility for families; and

WHEREAS, the funds currently available to the City are less than is needed to rehabilitate the facility; and

WHEREAS, the proposed use and the location match the criteria associated with Housing Trust Fund Redevelopment funds; and

WHEREAS, use of Housing Trust Fund Redevelopment funds carried over from FY00 requires amendment of the Commission's FY01 Budget, NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Housing Authority of The City of San Diego, that the

San Diego Housing Commission is authorized to expend \$415,000 towards the City's

rehabilitation of the Days Inn Motel property for use as a short-term transitional housing facility

for homeless families, as more particulary described in Housing Commission Report No. HCR

00-110.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Commission's FY01 Budget is hereby amended to

incorporate \$137,786 of Housing Trust Fund Redevelopment carryover funds for the proposed

use.
