ADOPTED ON JUNE 11, 2002

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER TO: (1) SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING OF A LEAD HAZARD CONTROL GRANT TO THE U. S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING & URBAN DEVELOPMENTS AND, IF FUNDS ARE AWARDED, (2) EXECUTE CONTRACTS WITH HUD TO ACCEPT THE FUNDS, AND (3) AMEND THE FY03 HOUSING COMMISSION BUDGET TO REFLECT THE ADDITIONAL FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the U. S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) published a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) for the Lead-Based Paint Hazard Control Grant Program for Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 2002; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Housing Commission seeks to apply for approximately \$1.5 million in funding for a Lead Hazard Control Grant Program to be implemented initially in a targeted area of the City of San Diego consisting of older homes likely to contain lead-based paint and occupied by low-income households with children; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Chief Executive Officer of the San Diego Housing Commission is authorized to: (1) apply to HUD for the new grant funding; and, if awarded, (2)

execute contracts with HUD to accept the funds; and (3) amend the FY03 Housing Commission

Budget to reflect receipt of the funds.
