A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF THE PROPOSED MARINA MIXED USE AMENDMENT TO THE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE CENTRE CITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT TO THE PROJECT AREA COMMITTEE FOR THE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego has heretofore adopted the Redevelopment Plan for the Centre City Redevelopment Project [the Project] on May 11, 1992, by Ordinance No. O-17767 (New Series), as amended on November 28, 1994 by Ordinance No. O-18119 (New Series), and January 9, 1995 by Ordinance No. O-18145 (New Series), and November 8, 1999, by Ordinance No. O-18708 (New Series), and November 8, 1999 by Ordinance No. O-18710 (New Series), and November 22, 1999, by Ordinance No. O-18723 (New Series), all pursuant to the California Community Redevelopment Law (Health & Safety Code 33000 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego [the Agency] has now prepared a proposed Marina Mixed Use Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Project, which proposed Marina Mixed Use Amendment conforms to the requirements of the California Community Redevelopment Law; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the California Community Redevelopment Law, the City Council has heretofore approved a representative project area committee for the Project [the Project Area Committee]; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the California Community Law, the Agency shall submit the

proposed Marina Mixed Use Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Project to the Project Area Committee, which may, if it chooses, prepare a report and recommendation thereon; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, is authorized and directed to submit the proposed Marina Mixed Use Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Project to the Project Area Committee for its report and recommendation pursuant to the California Community Redevelopment Law.

2. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, is further authorized and directed to submit to the City Council a report and summary of the meetings with, and recommendations and comments, if any, of the Project Area Committee on the proposed Marina Mixed Use Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan.

3. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, is authorized to take such steps as necessary and appropriate to implement the authorizations and directions established in this resolution.
