A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 WITH THE REYNOLDS GROUP FOR THE REMOVAL OF METAL CONTAMINATED SOIL IN THE MARINA SUB AREA OF THE CENTRE CITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT IN WHICH THE CONTRACT AMOUNT IS AMENDED TO \$264,812.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego [Agency] is engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan for the Centre City Redevelopment Project [Project] in downtown San Diego; and

WHEREAS, on or about December 12, 1999, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego [the Agency] entered into an agreement with The Reynolds Group, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Director of the Agency must approve any agreement amount that exceeds \$250,000; and

WHEREAS, during the soil removal process, it was determined to modify certain items as contained in Change Order No. 1; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, that it approves Change Order No. 1 for the removal of metal contaminated soil in the Marina Sub Area of the Centre City Redevelopment Project area and adds \$172,833 to the original contract for a total contract amount of \$264,812.
