A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO STATING FOR THE RECORD THAT THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT FOR THE NORTH BAY REVITALIZATION AREA (INCLUDING THE NORTH BAY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT) HAS BEEN REVIEWED AND CONSIDERED FOR THE ISSUANCE OF TAX ALLOCATION BONDS.

WHEREAS, in connection with the approval of the North Bay Revitalization Area (including the North Bay Redevelopment Project), the City Council by Resolution No. R-290053, adopted on May 4, 1998, certified a Final Environmental Impact Report (EIR) (SCH No. 97091022); a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the consideration of the issuance of tax allocation bonds for the North Bay Redevelopment Project, the City of San Diego has considered the issues discussed in the Final EIR; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego, that the information contained in the Final EIR, including any comments received during the public review process, has been reviewed and considered by this Agency and it is determined that no substantial changes or new information of substantial importance within the meaning of CEQA Guideline section 15162 would warrant any additional environmental review in connection with approval of the issuance of North Bay Redevelopment Project tax allocation bonds.
