A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF  
SAN DIEGO TERMINATING THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THE  
REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE MARKET STREET  
INDUSTRIAL PARK REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego [the Agency] and the Council of the City of San Diego [the Council] have established by ordinance, the Market Street Industrial Park Redevelopment Project [the Project]; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Plan for the Project conforms to the requirements of the California Community Redevelopment Law (California Health and Safety Code section 33000 et seq.) [the Law]; and

WHEREAS, the Project has successfully achieved the goals and objectives set forth in the Redevelopment Plan, and the limitation on the amount of tax increment funds to be collected by the Agency from the Project has been achieved; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Plan for the Project has come to the completion of its effectiveness and is proposed for termination; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego, that the effectiveness of the Redevelopment Plan for the Market Street Industrial Park Redevelopment Project is terminated.
