WHEREAS, for project areas for which a redevelopment plan was adopted on or after January 1, 1994, the implementation plan prepared in conjunction with the redevelopment plan constitutes the initial implementation plan; and

WHEREAS, California Community Redevelopment Law (codified at California Health and Safety Code section 33000 *et seq.*) requires the Agency, after a public hearing, to adopt an implementation plan every five years commencing with the fifth year after the redevelopment plan has been adopted; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego, that the

Second Five-Year Implementation Plan for the San Ysidro Redevelopment Project is approved, a
