ADOPTED ON JULY 10, 2001

A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE SALE OF CERTAIN PROPERTY IN THE CENTRE CITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA TO WATT COMMERCIAL ENTERPRISES; APPROVING THE DISPOSITION AND DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT PERTAINING THERETO; AND MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS WITH RESPECT TO SUCH DISPOSITION AND DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT AND SALE

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego [Agency] is engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan for the Centre City Redevelopment Project [Project] and has adopted an Implementation Plan for the Centre City Redevelopment Project in accordance with California Health and Safety Code section 33490 [Implementation Plan]; and

WHEREAS, in order to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan the Agency proposes to sell certain property in the Project Area to Watt Commercial Enterprises [Developer], pursuant to the terms and provisions of a certain Disposition and Development Agreement [Agreement], which Agreement contains a description of the property and provides for the rehabilitation and reuse of a development consisting of approximately 15,535 square-feet of retail/commercial space and 83,142 square-feet of office space; and

WHEREAS, the Developer has submitted to the Agency copies of said proposed Agreement in a form desired by the Developer; and

WHEREAS, the Centre City Development Corporation, Inc., has reviewed and discussed the proposed Agreement and has recommended that the Agency approve and enter into the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the California Community Redevelopment Law (California Health and Safety Code, section 33430 *et seq.*), the Agency held a public hearing on the proposed sale of the real property pursuant to the Agreement, having duly published notice of such public hearing and made copies of the proposed Agreement, and other reports and documents available for public inspection and comment; and

WHEREAS, the Agency has duly considered all terms and conditions of the proposed sale of real property and believes that the rehabilitation and reuse of the real property pursuant to the proposed Agreement is in the best interest of the City and the health, safety, morals and welfare of its residents, and in accord with the public purposes and provisions of applicable state and local law and requirements; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Agency recognizes that it has received and heard all oral and written objections to the proposed Agreement, to the proposed sale of the real property pursuant to the proposed Agreement, and to other matters pertaining to this transaction, and that all such oral and written objections are hereby overruled.

2. That the Agency hereby finds and determines that the consideration to be paid by the Developer for the sale of the real property as described in the Agreement is not less than the fair reuse value at the use and with the covenants and conditions and development costs

authorized by the Agreement. The Agency hereby finds and determines that all consideration to be paid under the Agreement is in amounts necessary to effectuate the purposes of the Redevelopment Plan for the Centre City Redevelopment Project.

3. That the Agency hereby finds and determines that the sale of the property will assist in the elimination of blight in the Centre City Redevelopment Project area, and is consistent with the Implementation Plan for the Project area.

4. That the sale of the real property and the Agreement which establishes the terms and conditions for the sale and development of the real property are hereby approved.

5. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute the Agreement, on behalf of the Agency, a copy of the Agreement when executed by the Agency shall be placed on file in the office of the Secretary to the Agency as Document No. 03353a and Right of Entry Agreement as Document No. 03353b.

6. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, is hereby authorized, on behalf of the Agency, to sign all documents necessary and appropriate to carry out and implement the Agreement and to administer the Agency's obligations, responsibilities and duties to be performed under the Agreement.
