A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE CENTRE CITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION TO ENTER INTO A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH NASLAND ENGINEERING FOR CIVIL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE CENTRE CITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego [Agency] is engaged

in activities necessary to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan for the Centre

City Redevelopment Project Area [Projects Area]; and

WHEREAS, the Centre City Development Corporation [CCDC] is responsible for

implementing redevelopment projects in the Project Area; and

WHEREAS, in order to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan, the Agency

proposes to pay for general engineering services; and

WHEREAS, on November 26, 2001, CCDC previously entered into an Agreement

[Agreement] for civil engineering services with Nasland Engineering [Nasland] in the amount of

\$234,780; a copy of the Agreement is on file in the Office of CCDC; and

WHEREAS, the Agency and Nasland wish to enter into a First Amendment to the

Agreement by increasing the maximum compensation provided for civil engineering services by

\$92,900, increasing the total contract amount to \$327,680; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, is authorized and empowered to prepare and execute, for and on behalf of the Agency, a First Amendment to the Agreement for Civil Engineering Services with Nasland Engineering, to provide for an increase in the amount of compensation in an amount not to exceed \$92,900, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$327,680. A copy of the First Amendment to the Agreement, when executed, shall be placed on file in the Office of the Secretary to the Agency as Document No. D-03472.

2. That this amendment adds a total of ninety-two thousand nine hundred dollars (\$92,900) to the original contract amount, thereby increasing the compensation of the Agreement to a total amount not to exceed three hundred twenty-seven thousand six hundred eighty dollars (\$327,680).
