A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE CONSTRUCTION AND INSTALLATION OF IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR. PROMENADE IN THE GASLAMP QUARTER AND THE MARINA SUB AREAS OF THE CENTRE CITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA, MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS WITH RESPECT TO THE PAYMENTS FOR THE IMPROVEMENTS AND AUTHORIZING THE CENTRE CITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION TO BID AND CONSTRUCT SAID IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego [the Agency] is engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan for the Gaslamp Quarter Sub Area and the Marina Sub Area of the Centre City Redevelopment Project [the Project]; and

WHEREAS, in order to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan, the Agency proposes to pay for all or part of the construction and installation of improvements for the Martin Luther King, Jr. Promenade; and

WHEREAS, Centre City Development Corporation [the Corporation] has reviewed and recommends that the Agency consent to and authorize the Corporation to bid and construct these improvements; and

WHEREAS, the Agency has duly considered all conditions of the proposed payment for

improvements and believes that the payment by the Agency of all or part of the cost of the installation and construction of these improvements by the Agency are in the best interest of the City and health, safety, morals and welfare of its residents, and in accord with the public purposes and provisions of applicable State and local law requirements, NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Agency finds and determines that the construction and installation of improvements for the Martin Luther King, Jr. Promenade for which Agency proposes to pay are of benefit to the Centre City Redevelopment Project, that the Agency finds and determines that no other reasonable means for financing the proposed improvements for which the Agency proposes to pay are available to the community, and that the Agency finds and determines that proposed improvements will assist in eliminating more blighting conditions inside the Project area, all as described in Attachment No. 1.

2. That the Agency finds and determines that the construction and installation of these improvements are consistent with the Implementation Plan adopted for the Project by the Agency on June 21, 1994, as Document No. 2141, pursuant to California Health and Safety Code section 33490, as described in Attachment No. 1.

3. That the Corporation, on behalf of the Agency, is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids for the construction and installation of these improvements in the Gaslamp Quarter and the Marina Sub Areas of the Centre City Redevelopment Project.

4. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, is authorized to award the contract to the lowest qualified bidder, provided the bid is within the established budget.

5. That the Corporation, on behalf of the Agency, is authorized to administer the contract.

6. That the total amount for the contract and agreement shall not exceed \$983,169.
