## REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO RESOLUTION NO. R-03041 ADOPTED ON SEPTEMBER 14, 1999

## A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AMENDING THE ANNUAL PROGRAM BUDGET PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED FOR FISCAL YEAR 1999-2000.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego [the Agency] is engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement redevelopment plans for the Centre City Redevelopment Project [the Project] area of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the Centre City Development Corporation, Inc. [CCDC], has been

authorized to administer the redevelopment projects in the Project area; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, as

follows:

1. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, is authorized:

a. To amend the Fiscal Year 2000 Budget by increasing the Marina Sub Area

budget by \$2,000,000; and

b. To amend the Fiscal Year 2000 Budget by increasing the Horton Plaza

City Loan Repayment budget by \$830,000; and

c. To amend the Fiscal Year 2000 Budget by decreasing the Area WidePublic Improvements budget by \$400,000.

2. That approval of this amendment constitutes authority for the expenditure of funds by CCDC in Fiscal Year 1999-2000 provided that funds are available from disposition

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proceeds, developer advances, tax increment generated by the Project area, and from funds as may be allocated by the Council of The City of San Diego from various sources.

3. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized:

a. To establish the necessary accounts; and

b. To appropriate and to allot all monies available in each project fund up to the amount of revenues available in each project fund.

4. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized to carry forward any unexpended balance remaining in each budgetary account at the end of each fiscal year into the next fiscal year as a continuing appropriation, subject to amendment by the Agency.

5. That the President of CCDC, or designee, is authorized to expend funds as appropriate for the implementation of the East Village Fund, the Core/Columbia Project Fund, the Gaslamp Project Fund, and the Area Wide Project Fund.

6. That CCDC's President, or designee, is authorized to request the City Auditor and Comptroller to make budgetary transfers between the line items and object accounts within each project fund.

7. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is authorized, upon the request of CCDC, to transfer or loan funds between sub-projects within a project, provided that such transfers or loans do not increase or decrease the total project budgets or result in a use of such funds which would be inconsistent with the permitted uses of such funds.

8. That in the event the Agency desires to issue bonds, notes, or other instruments of indebtedness of the Agency to carry out redevelopment projects, any indebtedness of the Agency to the City of San Diego, including any interest accrued thereon, shall be deemed not to be a first pledge of tax increment allocations received by the Agency pursuant to California Health and Safety Code section 33670; and any indebtedness of the Agency to the City of San Diego,

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including any interest accrued thereon, shall be subordinate to any pledge of tax increments to

bondholders or the holders of other such instruments of indebtedness.
