RESOLUTION NO.1034

ADOPTED ON DECEMBER 7, 1999

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) has announced the availability of funding for the Resident Opportunities and Self-Sufficiency (ROSS) program which provides grants to link residents to supportive services and empowerment activities which will lead to self-sufficiency and to support independent living for the elderly and disabled; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Commission is committed to providing opportunities for residents to further economic self-sufficiency and self-improvement for families and to assist elderly and disabled residents to live independently; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Commission desires to apply to HUD for \$250,000 in federal funds in order to upgrade Learning Opportunity Centers, provide technical training, and improve linkages to the Welfare-to-Work Career Center Network and for \$55,985 to continue coordination of support services for the elderly and disabled; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Commission on November 19, 1999, recommended authorization for the Chief Executive Officer to submit an application to HUD for these programs; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Housing Authority of The City of San Diego, that the Chief Executive Officer or her designee is authorized to submit an application to HUD for the ROSS

program.
