## REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO RESOLUTION NO. R-03646 ADOPTED ON JUNE 17, 2003

A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2003 SEDC ADMINISTRATION BUDGET TO PROVIDE FUNDS FOR CONSULTANT SERVICES ASSOCIATED WITH THE CORPORATION'S RELOCATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000, A RE-ALLOCATION FROM PERSONNEL TO NON-PERSONNEL CATEGORY.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego [Agency] approved the Fiscal Year 2003 Redevelopment Agency budget on June 18, 2002, a copy of which is on file in the office of the secretary to the Agency as Document No. D-03511; and

WHEREAS, Resolution Number R-03484 adopted the SEDC's Administration Annual Budget for Fiscal Year 2002-2003 totaled \$1,673,000 which included two major categories: Personnel (\$1,149,000) and Non-Personnel (\$524,100); and

WHEREAS, subsequent changes in personnel coupled with the anticipated Relocation of SEDC's corporate offices have resulted in the need to amend SEDC's Administrative Budget to accommodate certain non-personnel expenses to cover the cost associated with various consultants hired to facilitate SEDC's corporate relocation; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego, that the Fiscal Year 2003 SEDC's Administrative budget is hereby amended to re-allocate \$50,000 from the personnel category of the said aforementioned budget to the non-personnel category. The re-

allocation will not change the approved SEDC FY 2002-2003 administrative budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that authorization is provided to allow for funds to cover for cost associated with the various consultants hired to facilitate SEDC's corporate relocation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that approval of this budget amendment constitutes authority for expenditure of these funds by SEDC in Fiscal Year 2003.
