A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS WITH RESPECT TO FUNDING THE ACQUISITION OF LAND FOR THE VIETNAM VETERANS VILLAGE PROJECT IN THE NORTH BAY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego [Agency] is engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan for the North Bay Redevelopment Project; and,

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego [City] owns real property known as 4141 Pacific
Highway, portions of the Public Right-of-Way at Pacific Highway (the Frontage Road) and
Kurtz Street, between Couts Street and Witherby Street, and portions of Witherby Street between
Pacific Highway (the Frontage Road) and Kurtz Street, in the North Bay Redevelopment Project,
[the Property] more specifically described in Exhibit A to this resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Agency has negotiated and proposes to enter into a Disposition and Development Agreement [DDA] with the Vietnam Veterans of San Diego [Developer] pursuant to which the Agency will acquire the Property from the City in order to sell the Property to the Developer to develop a state of the art living and support facility for the treatment of homeless veterans [Development]; and

WHEREAS, the Agency will use tax increment money to pay for the value of the Property;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego that the

Agency finds and determines that the acquisition of the land for the Veterans Village Project, for

which the Agency proposes to contribute funding, is of benefit to the North Bay Redevelopment

Project; will assist in the elimination of one or more blighting conditions within the North Bay

Redevelopment Project Area; that no other reasonable means of financing the acquisition of the

land is available to the community; and that the acquisition of the land is consistent with the Five

Year Implementation Plan for the North Bay Redevelopment Project, as adopted and thereafter

amended by the Agency pursuant to California Health and Safety Code section 33490, as

described in Attachment No. 1.
