A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO CONSENTING TO A JOINT PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED FOURTH AMENDMENT TO THE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE CENTRAL IMPERIAL REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A DATE, TIME, AND PLACE FOR THE HEARING; AND AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION AND MAILING OF NOTICE OF THE JOINT PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego [Agency] has prepared a proposed Fourth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Central Imperial Redevelopment Project [Project], and the proposed Fourth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan conforms to the requirements of the California Community Redevelopment Law (Cal. Health & Safety Code § 33000 *et seq.*) [Law]; and

WHEREAS, the Law provides for a joint public hearing on the proposed Fourth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Project with the consent of the Agency and the Council of the City of San Diego [Council]; and

WHEREAS, the Council, by Resolution No. R-298530, has consented to a joint public hearing on the proposed First Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Project and has requested that the Agency consent to the joint public hearing and establish the date, time, and place for the hearing; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Agency consents to a joint public hearing with the Council on the proposed Fourth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Project, and authorizes the City Clerk, in cooperation with the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, to establish the date, time, and place for the hearing.

2. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, in cooperation with the City Clerk, shall publish and mail the notice of joint public hearing on the proposed Fourth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan, in the manner, and with other documents, as required and established by law.
