A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE THIRD (NEW) FIVE-YEAR IMPLEMENTATION PLANS (2004-2009) FOR THE CENTRAL IMPERIAL, GATEWAY CENTER WEST, MOUNT HOPE AND SOUTHCREST REDEVELOPMENT PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, California Community Redevelopment Law (codified at California Health and Safety Code section 33000 et seq.) requires the preparation and approval of five-year implementation plans, and subsequent five-year implementation plans each five years thereafter, for all redevelopment projects adopted before January 1, 1994; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 03018 on July 20, 1999, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego [Agency] approved the second Five-Year Implementation Plans for the Central Imperial, Gateway Center West, Mount Hope and Southcrest Redevelopment Projects; and

WHEREAS, the board of the Southeastern Economic Development Corporation [SEDC] reviewed and approved the third (new) implementation plans; and

WHEREAS, the Project Area Committees [PAC] where existing, have reviewed and approved their respective third (new) implementation plans for their project areas; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego, that the third (new) five-year implementation plans (2004-2009) are hereby approved and are on file in the office of the Secretary to the Agency as follows:
