A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE FIRST IMPLEMENTATION AGREEMENT TO THE DISPOSITION AND DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY AND ROSEAU DEVELOPMENT COMPANY NO. 2, LLC.

Roseau Development Company No. 2, LLC [Developer]; and

WHEREAS, in order to further implement the development under the DDA, the Agency

and Developer propose (pursuant to the terms and conditions of the First Implementation

Agreement) to amend the DDA, to provide for changes to the Schedule of Performance, Method

of Financing, modify the Grant Deeds, and to make other changes deemed appropriate by the

parties; and

WHEREAS, Southeastern Economic Development Corporation [SEDC], has reviewed and discussed the proposed First Implementation Agreement; and WHEREAS, the Agency has duly considered the recommendations of SEDC and all the terms and conditions of the proposed First Implementation Agreement and believes that the changes contained therein are in the best interest of the City and the health, safety, morals and welfare of its residents, and in accord with the public purposes and provisions of applicable state and local law and requirements; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego, as follows:

 That it approves the First Implementation Agreement Roseau Development Company No. 2, LLC , a copy of which is on file in the office of the secretary to the Agency as Document No. D-03811.

2. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, is hereby authorized for and on behalf of the Agency, to execute the First Implementation Agreement and to administer the Agency's obligations, responsibilities, and duties to be performed thereunder.
