A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH KANE, BALLMER & BERKMAN FOR SPECIAL LEGAL COUNSEL SERVICES IN THE CENTRE CITY AND HORTON PLAZA REDEVELOPMENT PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, in July 2001, the Agency issued a Request for Qualifications for Legal Service seeking outside counsel with specific expertise in the area of redevelopment law; and

WHEREAS, in December 2001, the Agency and Kane, Ballmer & Berkman (Special Counsel) entered into an Agreement for Special Counsel to provide legal services to the Agency in the area of redevelopment law; and

WHEREAS, the Agency approved the Agreement between the Agency and Special Counsel pursuant to Resolution No. R-3413 adopted on December 3, 2001; and

WHEREAS, a Scope of Services was executed between the parties to the Agreement with compensation not to exceed the amount of \$1,500,000; and

WHEREAS, the Agency approved the First Amendment to the Agreement pursuant to Resolution No. R-3674 adopted on September 2, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the Agency approved the Second Amendment to the Agreement pursuant to

Resolution No. R-3814 adopted on September 14, 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Agency now wishes to enter into the Third Amendment to the

Agreement; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego, that the

Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, is authorized and empowered to execute, for and

on behalf of the Agency, the Third Amendment to Agreement with Kane, Ballmer & Berkman

for special legal counsel services, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Third

Amendment to the Agreement, a copy of which is on file in the office of the Secretary to the

Agency as Document No. D-03935.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that an additional expenditure in an amount not to

exceed \$210,000 on an as needed basis is authorized by the Third Amendment to the Agreement

solely and exclusively, for the purpose of providing funding for the agreement with Kane,

Ballmer & Berkman.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the total expenditures for the Agreement shall not

exceed \$2,322,860.
