WHEREAS, the Agency now wishes to enter into Agreements with Robinson and Pearman, LLP and Hawkins Delafield & Wood LLP for bond/disclosure counsel services; NOW, THEREFORE; BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego, that the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, is authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of the Agency, the Agreements with Robinson and Pearman LLP and Hawkins Delafield & Wood LLP for bond/disclosure counsel services, under the terms and conditions set forth in said Agreements, of which copies are on file in the office of the Secretary to the Agency Redenant & Pearman & Hawkins Delafield 9 Wood X 2P as Documents No. D 04148 a. D-04148

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funds for these Agreements will be secured from the proceeds of the sale of the bonds, and that compensation for services rendered under these Agreements is dependent upon an actual successful tax allocation bond issuance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this activity is not a "project" and is therefore exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15060(c)(3).
