A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE PLANNING AND ADMINISTRATION EXPENSES TO BE FUNDED IN FISCAL YEAR 2009 BY THE LOW AND MODERATE INCOME HOUSING FUNDS ARE NECESSARY AND IN PROPORTION TO THE FUNDING TO BE PROVIDED FOR THE PRODUCTION, IMPROVEMENT AND/OR PRESERVATION OF AFFORDABLE HOUSING FOR LOW AND MODERATE INCOME HOUSEHOLDS.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego [the Agency] is engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement redevelopment plans for the City of San Diego [City]; and

WHEREAS, the Centre City Development Corporation, Inc. [CCDC] has been authorized to administer the redevelopment projects in the Centre City area; and

WHEREAS, the Southeastern Economic Development Corporation, Inc. [SEDC] has been authorized to administer the redevelopment projects in the Southeastern San Diego area; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Division of the City's City Planning & Community
Investment Department [City Redevelopment] has been authorized to administer the
redevelopment projects in all areas of the City other than Centre City and Southeastern San
Diego; and

WHEREAS, a description of redevelopment activities is contained in the City's Fiscal Year 2009 Proposed Budget, which is on file in the office of the secretary to the Agency as Document No $\sqrt{278}$; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 33334.2 (a) of the California Community

Redevelopment Law (Health and Safety Code Section 33000 et seq.) not less than 20% of all
taxes which are allocated to the Agency shall be set aside by the Agency in a Low and Moderate
Income Housing Fund and used by the Agency for the purpose of increasing, improving and
preserving the community's supply of low- and moderate-income housing available at affordable
housing costs to people and families of low- and moderate-income, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 33334.3 (d) of the California Community

Redevelopment Law (Health and Safety Code Section 33000 et seq.) it is the intent of the

California State Legislature that the amount of money spent for planning and general

administration from the Low and Moderate Income Housing Fund not be disproportionate to the

amount actually spent for the cost of production; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego as follows: the Agency hereby determines that the amounts included for planning and administration in the Fiscal Year 2009 Redevelopment Agency Low and Moderate Income Housing Funds are necessary and are proportionate to the funding to be expended for the production, improvement, and/or preservation of low- and moderate-income housing during Fiscal Year 2009.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this activity is not a "project" and is therefore exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act ["CEQA"] pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15060(c)(3).
