A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND THE SAN DIEGO HOUSING COMMISSION AND PROVIDING CERTAIN AUTHORIZATIONS IN CONNECTION WITH THE ADMINISTRATION AND MANAGEMENT OF THE COLLEGE GROVE REDEVELOPMENT HOUSING ENHANCEMENT LOAN PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego [Agency] is engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan for the College Grove Redevelopment Project Area [Project Area]; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to California Health and Safety Code Section 33334.2 of the California Community Redevelopment Law [CRL], the Agency must set aside twenty percent (20%) of tax increment funds generated in a project area to be used for the purposes of increasing, improving, and preserving the community's supply of low- and moderate- income housing available at affordable housing cost to persons and families of low or moderate income and very low income households; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 33334.2(e)(7) of the CRL, the Agency may exercise any or all of its powers to carry out the purposes set forth in Section 33334.2, including providing for the rehabilitation of buildings or structures that benefit persons and families of low or moderate income; and

WHEREAS, in order to carry out and implement the objectives and goals of the Redevelopment Plan for the Project Area and the CRL, the Agency created the College Grove Redevelopment Housing Enhancement Loan Program [College Grove HELP] to provide housing enhancement/rehabilitation loans to owner-occupants of eligible one- and two- unit properties within the Project Area or outside the Project Area in the surrounding neighborhoods located in census tracts 27.05 and 27.06 [College Grove HELP Area], whose gross household income is no greater than 100% of the area median family income [AMI] for San Diego County; and

WHEREAS, subject to the availability of College Grove HELP funds, the Agency would loan to an eligible owner-occupant of an eligible property an amount up to \$20,000 to be used toward rehabilitating and enhancing the interior and exterior conditions of the owner-occupant's dwelling and an additional amount up to \$5,000 to be used toward providing water conserving landscape improvements and/or energy conserving improvements to the subject property; and

WHEREAS, the Agency's loan would be forgivable over a ten (10) year period and evidenced by a Memorandum of Lien Affecting Real Property recorded against a subject property that is subordinate in priority to any and all rights of an institutional first mortgage holder, concurrent mortgage holder and/or prior issuer of home equity lines of credit, whose deed of trust is secured by the subject property; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Housing Commission currently provides effective services in the administration and management of Redevelopment Housing Enhancement Loan Programs in the City Heights, San Ysidro, North Park, Crossroads and Linda Vista Redevelopment Project Areas; and

WHEREAS, in light of the above, the Agency and the San Diego Housing Commission propose to enter into an Agreement which authorizes the San Diego Housing Commission to


provide the necessary administration and management services for the College Grove HELP, including management and expenditure of the Agency funds allocated toward the College Grove HELP; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego [Agency] as follows:

1. That the Agency approves the Agreement [Agreement] by and between the Agency and the San Diego Housing Commission, and the Exhibits attached thereto, for administration and management services in connection with the College Grove HELP.
2. That the Agency authorizes the San Diego Housing Commission to administer and manage the College Grove HELP on behalf of the Agency pursuant to the adopted Guidelines for the College Grove HELP [Guidelines], and as said Guidelines may be amended in writing by the Agency, and in accordance with the Agreement.
3. That the Agency authorizes the San Diego Housing Commission to administer and manage the expenditure of the Agency funds allocated toward the College Grove HELP.
4. That the Agency authorizes the San Diego Housing Commission to execute on behalf of the Agency the Memorandum of Lien Affecting Real Property, attached as Exhibit "A" to the Guidelines, to be recorded against each subject property that is assisted by the College Grove HELP.
5. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of the Agency, the Agreement, a copy of which shall be placed on file in the office of the secretary of the Agency as Document No. D- 04382.
6. That this activity is not a "project" for purposes of the California Environmental Quality Act [CEQA] because it does not meet the criteria set forth in CEQA Guidelines Section

15378. Therefore, pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15060(c)(3), this activity is not subject to CEQA.


