A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO [REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY] (i) STATING FOR THE RECORD THAT THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, AS RESPONSIBLE AGENCY, HAS REVIEWED AND CONSIDERED THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION (LDR 41-0980) AND THE ADDENDUM THERETO (LDR 41-0980) FOR THE NEW CENTRAL LIBRARY PROJECT AND THE FINAL ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT PREPARED FOR THE DOWNTOWN COMMUNITY PLAN; (ii) APPROVING THAT CERTAIN COOPERATION AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY AND THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE NEW CENTRAL LIBRARY PROJECT; (iii) AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF THE REMAINING \$62,930,000 OF PREVIOUSLY COMMITTED REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY FUNDS TO ASSIST WITH FUNDING A PORTION OF THE COSTS OF CONSTRUCTION OF THE NEW CENTRAL LIBRARY PROJECT LOCATED WITHIN THE EAST VILLAGE REDEVELOPMENT DISTRICT OF THE EXPANSION SUB AREA OF THE CENTRE CITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA: AND (iv) AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE COOPERATION AGREEMENT AND TAKE RELATED ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego [Agency] is engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan for the Centre City Redevelopment Project Area [Project Area]; and

WHEREAS, the Centre City Development Corporation [Corporation] is authorized to administer, on behalf of the Agency, the Project Area; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Resolution No. R-296575 adopted on May 28, 2002, the City of San Diego [City] acting as the "lead agency" for purposes of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, California Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq. [CEQA], as amended, certified a Mitigated Negative Declaration (LDR 41-0980) [2002 MND] and adopted the Mitigation, Monitoring and Reporting Program for the New Central Library project (previously referred to as the San Diego New Main Library project); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to City Resolution No. R-297750 adopted on March 24, 2003, the City certified an Addendum to the MND (LDR 41-0980A) [2003 Addendum] for the New Central Library project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. R-04001 with final passage on March 14, 2006, the Agency, acting as the designated "lead agency" for purposes of CEQA, has previously certified the Final Environmental Impact Report for the San Diego Downtown Community Plan, Centre City Planned District Ordinance and Tenth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Centre City Redevelopment Project [2006 Final EIR], on file in the office of the Agency Secretary as Document No. D-04001a, which includes analysis of the build-out of the Downtown Community Plan area which includes the site of the New Central Library, and the New Central Library is consistent with the Downtown Community Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City's Development Services Department completed evaluations pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15162 dated October 9, 2009 and October 26, 2009, and determined that no further environmental review under CEQA was required for the New Central Library project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Agency Resolution No. R-03893 dated April 19, 2005 and City Resolution No. R-3003358 dated April 19, 2005, the Agency Board and the City Council,

respectively, made the findings required by California Health and Safety Code sections 33445 and 33679 for the Agency's expenditure of Agency funds toward the costs of construction of the New Central Library project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Agency Resolution No. R-03893 dated April 19, 2005 and City Resolution No. R-300358 dated April 19, 2005 (incorrectly numbered on the City Resolution as R-3003358), the Agency, with the City Council's consent, approved up to \$80 million of tax increment from the Centre City Redevelopment Project to assist with the funding of a portion of the costs of construction of the New Central Library project to be located on the block bounded by 11th Avenue, J Street on the north and Park Boulevard to the south in the East Village Redevelopment District of the Expansion Sub Area of the Centre City Redevelopment Project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Agency Resolution No. R-2489 dated May 2, 1995 and Agency Resolution No. R-03894 dated April 19, 2005, the Agency approved the expenditure of up to \$16.5 Million of Agency funds previously committed for the New Central Library project; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Agency Resolution No. R-04454 dated November 12, 2009, the Agency approved the expenditure of up to \$570,000 of the previously committed Agency funds to assist with funding a portion of the costs of construction of the New Central Library project; and

WHEREAS, the Agency is hereby being requested to expend and contribute to the City the remaining Sixty Two Million Nine Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$62,930,000) of the previously committed Agency funds to assist with the costs of construction of the New Central Library project; and

WHEREAS, the Agency and the City desire to enter into a Cooperation Agreement

[Cooperation Agreement] in order to establish certain terms for the construction of the New

Central Library project including, without limitation, the funding for the construction of the New

Central Library project, construction responsibilities and maintenance responsibilities; and

WHEREAS, the Agency finds and determines that the Agency's funding of certain costs associated with the New Central Library project and entering into the Cooperation Agreement are consistent with the goals and objectives of the Redevelopment Plan for the Project Area and the City's Downtown Community Plan, is in the best interests of the City and the Project Area and the health, safety, morals and welfare of its residents, and is in accord with the public purposes and provisions of applicable state and local law and requirements; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego [Agency] as follows:

- 1. That the Agency, as a Responsible Agency under CEQA, hereby states for the record that the Agency has reviewed and considered the information contained in the 2002 MND, and the 2003 Addendum thereto, and the 2006 Final EIR, including any comments received during the public review process.
- 2. That the Agency hereby approves the Cooperation Agreement by and between the Agency and the City of San Diego for the construction of the New Central Library project.
- 3. That the Agency hereby authorizes the expenditure and contribution to the City of San Diego of up to of Sixty Two Million Nine Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$62,930,000) to be used toward the development of the New Central Library project, thereby raising the total authorized expenditures toward the construction of the New Central Library project to \$80 Million, the total committed Agency funding amount.

- 4. That the Agency hereby authorizes the Chief Financial Officer, as delegated, to expend up to Sixty Two Million Nine Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$62,930,000) designated New Central Library project through the transfer of Forty Two Million Ninety Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Ninety Nine Dollars and Seventy Six Cents (\$42,099,999.76) of tax increment funds from the Project Area to the CC Contribution to City of San Diego, Fund No. 200633 and the transfer of Twenty Million Eight Hundred Thirty Thousand Dollars and Twenty Four Cents (\$20,830,000.24) of proceeds from the Centre City Tax Allocation Bonds, Series 2004 A bond issuance to the Capital Improvement Program Budget, WBS No. S-00799 New Central Library, Fund No. 200629 CC Contribution to City of San Diego TE 2004A, as the Agency's contribution to the City of San Diego to be used toward the development of the New Central Library project, which transfers are contingent upon the approvals of the San Diego City Council of that certain Construction Manager At Risk Construction Services Agreement by and between the City and Turner Construction Company.
- 5. That the Agency hereby authorizes the Chief Financial Officer, as delegated, to transfer back to the Agency any and all funds remaining in either the CC Contribution to City of San Diego, Fund No. 200633 or the Capital Improvement Program Budget, WBS No. S-00799 New Central Library, Fund No. 200629 CC Contribution to City of San Diego TE 2004A, the Agency's contribution to the City of San Diego, upon any cost savings of the New Central Library project.
- 6. That the President of Centre City Development Corporation, Inc. or designee is hereby authorized to expend funds as appropriate and consistent with this Resolution from the budget approved for the Centre City Redevelopment Project.
- 7. That the Agency authorizes the Executive Director or designee, for and on behalf of the Agency, to execute the Cooperation Agreement and to administer the Agency's

obligations, responsibilities and duties to be performed thereunder.

8. That the City Clerk, or designee, is hereby authorized and directed to cause the filing of a Notice of Determination with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Diego.
