## REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO RESOLUTION NO. 2997

ADOPTED ON JUNE 1, 1999

A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE CONSTRUCTION OF IMPROVEMENTS ON CEDAR STREET AND THE INTERSECTION OF CEDAR STREET AND THIRD AVENUE IN THE CORTEZ REDEVELOPMENT DISTRICT OF THE EXPANSION SUB AREA OF THE CENTRE CITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA, MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS WITH RESPECT TO THE PAYMENTS FOR THE IMPROVEMENTS AND AUTHORIZING THE CENTRE CITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION TO BID AND CONSTRUCT SAID IMPROVEMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego [Agency] is engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan for the Cortez Redevelopment District Area of the Centre City Redevelopment Project [Project]; and WHEREAS, in order to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan, the Agency proposes to pay for all or part of the construction of improvements in Cedar Street and the intersection of Cedar Street and Third Avenue; and

WHEREAS, Centre City Development Corporation [Corporation] has reviewed and recommends that the Agency consent to and authorize the Corporation to bid and construct the improvements in Cedar Street and the intersection of Cedar Street and Third Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the Agency has duly considered all conditions of the proposed payment for improvements and believes that the payment by the Agency of all or part of the cost of the installation and construction of these Improvements by the Agency are in the best interest of the

City and health, safety, morals and welfare of its residents, and in accord with the public purposes and provisions of applicable State and local law requirements; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the Agency finds and determines that the construction of the improvements in Cedar Street and the intersection of Cedar Street and Third Avenue for which Agency proposes to pay are of benefit to the Centre City Redevelopment Project, that the Agency finds and determines that no other reasonable means for financing the proposed improvements for which the Agency proposes to pay are available to the community, and that the Agency finds and determines that proposed improvements will assist in eliminating one or more blighting conditions inside the Project area, all as described in Attachment 1.
- 2. That the Agency finds and determines that the construction of these improvements are consistent with the Implementation Plan adopted for the Project by the Agency on June 21, 1994, as Document No. 2141, pursuant to California Health and Safety Code section 33490, as described in Attachment 1.
- 3. That the Corporation, on behalf of the Agency, is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids for public street improvements in the Cortez Redevelopment District of the Expansion Sub Area of the Centre City Redevelopment Project.
- 4. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, is authorized to award the contract to the lowest qualified bidder, provided the bid is within the established budget.
- 5. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or designee, is authorized to purchase street trees, tree grates, trash receptacles and street lights for the project.
- 6. That the Corporation, on behalf of the Agency, is authorized to administer the contract.

7. That the total amount for the contract and agreement shall not exceed \$114,000.
