A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE APPLICATION AND THE PROJECT AGREEMENT FOR HISTORIC PRESERVATION GRANTS-IN-AID FUNDS FOR WILLIAM HEATH DAVIS HOUSE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Congress under Public Law 89-665 has authorized the establishment of a National Historic Preservation Grants-in-Aid Program, providing matching funds to the State of California and its political subdivisions for historic preservation, survey, planning, development, and acquisition projects; and

WHEREAS, the California Office of Historic Preservation is responsible for the administration of the program within the State, setting up necessary rules and procedures governing application by local agencies under the program; and

WHEREAS, said adopted procedures established by the California Office of Historic Preservation require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of applications and the availability of local matching funds prior to submission for said applications to the State; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. Approves the filing of an application for the National Historic Preservation Grants-in-Aid assistance for project.

2. Appoints the Executive Director, or his designee, to coordinate, process and execute all contracts, agreements, amendments and ancillary documents within the scope of the attached application.

3. Agrees that all required local matching funds have been provided for the project pursuant to Agency Resolution No. 848 (passed May 24, 1983).
