A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO CONSENTING TO A JOINT PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE DELLS REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION AND MAILING OF NOTICE OF JOINT PUBLIC HEARING ON SAID PROPOSED FIRST AMENDMENT.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency"), has prepared a proposed First Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Dells Redevelopment Project; and

WHEREAS, the proposed First Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Dells Redevelopment Project conforms to the requirements of the California Community Redevelopment Law (Sections 33000 et seq., Health and Safety Code); and

WHEREAS, the California Community Redevelopment Law (Section 33458) authorizes a joint public hearing on the proposed First Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Dells Redevelopment Project, with the consent of the Agency and the City Council of The City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The Agency hereby consents to a joint public hearing with the City Council of The City of San Diego on the proposed First Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Dells Redevelopment Project, and further, hereby

requests that the City Council of The City of San Diego consent to a joint public hearing on the proposed First Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan and establish the date, time and place therefor.

2. The Executive Director of the Agency (or his designee) shall, in cooperation with the City Clerk of The City of San Diego, publish and mail notice of public hearing on the proposed First Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan, in the manner, and with other documents as required and established by law.
