A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE
EXPENDITURE OF \$17,999.55 TO ATCHISON, TOPEKA
AND SANTA FE RAILROAD FOR RELOCATION OF
UTILITY LINES ON A POLE IN PARCEL "A" IN THE
MARINA/COLUMBIA RESIDENTIAL PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego
(the "Agency"), entered into a Disposition and Development
Agreement with Pardee Construction Company and San Diego Federal
Savings and Loan (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, under the terms of said Agreement the Agency is
responsible for the removal of certain utilities; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the payment of \$17,999.55 to Atchison,
Topeka and Santa Fe Railroad is hereby authorized for the removal

of the utility lines on a pole located at Kettner and "G" Streets
in the Marina/Columbia Residential Project.
