WITH O'MELVENY & MYERS FOR BOND COUNSEL

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of
San Diego, that the Executive Director, of his designee, is
hereby authorized and empowered to accept and execute for and on
behalf of the Agency, a letter agreement dated April 17, 1984,
with O'Melveny & Myers for bond counsel services for a maximum

amount of \$97,500. A copy of said letter agreement is on file in the office of the Secretary to the Agency as Document No. 1066.
