A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE FIRST
IMPLEMENTATION AGREEMENT TO THE DISPOSITION
AND DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE
REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY AND DAN W. PEARSON.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego
(the "Agency"), is engaged in activities necessary to carry out
and implement the Redevelopment Plan for the Marina Redevelopment
Project; and

WHEREAS, in order to carry out and implement such
Redevelopment Plan, the Agency has heretofore agreed to provide
for the development of a hotel and related facilities on the
relocation site and expansion site pursuant to the terms and
provisions of a Disposition and Development Agreement dated

October 26, 1983 (the "Agreement"); and

a form desired by the Developer; and

WHEREAS, in order to further implement the development under said Agreement, the Agency proposes (pursuant to the terms and provisions of a First Implementation Agreement to the Agreement), to provide for certain appropriate changes in said Agreement; and WHEREAS, the Developer has executed and submitted to the Agency copies of said proposed First Implementation Agreement in

WHEREAS, the Centre City Development Corporation, Inc.

("CCDC") has reviewed and discussed said proposed First

Implementation Agreement and has recommended that the Agency
enter into the First Implementation Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Supplemental Master Environmental Impact Report for the Centre City Redevelopment Projects ("MEIR") included as an implementation activity the development of hotel and related development in the Marina Redevelopment Project and the City Council by Resolution No. 259511 and the Agency by Resolution No. 882, certified the Secondary Study of Environmental Impacts with respect to such development, and the proposed First Implementation Agreement does not change the development or environmental impacts thereof; and

WHEREAS, the Agency has duly considered all terms and conditions of the proposed First Implementation Agreement, and

believes that the changes contained in the proposed First

Implementation Agreement are in the best interests of the City

and the health, safety, morals and welfare of its residents, and
in accord with the public purposes and provisions of applicable

State and local law and requirements; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the proposed First Implementation Agreement and the terms and conditions thereof are hereby approved.
- 2. That the Agency hereby finds and determines that the certifications, findings and determinations with respect to environmental impacts in the Marina Redevelopment Project as set forth in Resolution No. 417 are not changed by the proposed First Implementation Agreement, and such certifications, findings and determinations are hereby ratified in their entirety.
- 3. That the Chairman of the Agency is hereby authorized to execute the First Implementation Agreement on behalf of the Agency.
- 4. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or his designee, is hereby authorized on behalf of the Agency to sign all documents necessary and appropriate to carry out and implement the First Implementation Agreement and to administer the Agency's obligations, responsibilities and duties to be

performed under the First Implementation Agreement.
