Inc., and the Gaslamp Quarter Council have agreed on a Memorandum

of Understanding relative to the elimination of certain

nonconforming uses and physically blighted conditions on Fourth

Avenue between Broadway and "G" Street in the Gaslamp Quarter

Redevelopment Project; NOW, THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of

San Diego, that the Executive Director, or his designee, is

hereby authorized, on behalf of the Agency, to execute the

Memorandum of Understanding with the Centre City Development

Corporation, Inc. and the Gaslamp Quarter Council for the

elimination of certain nonconforming uses and physically blighted

conditions on Fourth Avenue between Broadway and "G" Street

located in the Gaslamp Quarter Redevelopment Project area on file
