(RA-85-145) REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO RESOLUTION NO. 1093 ADOPTED ON MAY 21, 1985

A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING A STREET BANNER PROGRAM FOR THE OPENING OF HORTON PLAZA.

WHEREAS, the Centre City Development Corporation is proposing to sponsor several events to assist in the opening of Horton Plaza; the street banner program represents the longest lead-time project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego, by Resolution No. R-262932, adopted on April 15, 1985, approved the program in concept and have authorized the City Engineer to grant a permit for this program; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency"), as follows: 1. That the Centre City Development Corporation is hereby authorized, on behalf of the Agency, to advertise and receive bids for the fabrication of street banners (including clamprings and suspension arms) and the installation/tear down of these street banners on the streets designated.

2. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or his designee, is hereby authorized to award a contract to the lowest qualified bidder, provided the bids are within the established budget.

3. That the expenditure shall not exceed \$20,000.00 for the fabrication of street banners and installation and tear down of these banners from the Horton Plaza Redevelopment Project Fund No. 98440.

4. That the Centre City Development Corporation is hereby authorized, on behalf of the Agency, to administer the contract.

5. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or his designee, is hereby authorized to enter into a licensing agreement with San Diego Gas & Electric Company for the use of designated utility poles for the street banner program.
