RESOLUTION NO. 1109

ADOPTED ON JUNE 11, 1985

A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF  
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING A CONTRACT  
WITH THE FIRM KUTAK, ROCK AND CAMPBELL FOR  
BOND COUNSEL SERVICES FOR THE SALE OF  
MULTIFAMILY REVENUE HOUSING BONDS FOR THE  
MARINA RESIDENTIAL PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego  
(the "Agency") has undertaken activities necessary for the  
planning and execution of redevelopment projects pursuant to the  
California Community Redevelopment Law; and

WHEREAS, such activities include the development of the  
Marina Residential Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Agency has previously sold two separate issues  
of Residential Mortgage Revenue Bonds totalling \$61,425,000.00 to

assist in the financing of residential development in the  
Project; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed appropriate to enter into this contract  
between the Agency and the firm Kutak, Rock and Campbell; NOW,  
THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of  
San Diego, that the Executive Director, or his designee, is  
hereby authorized to execute a contract with Kutak, Rock and  
Campbell for bond counsel services relative to the issuance of  
multifamily revenue bonds. A copy of said agreement is on file  
in the office of the Secretary to the Agency as Document No.  
1202.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that compensation for bond counsel  
services will be contingent on the sale of bonds and that such  
payment for this contract will be made from bond proceeds.  
Additionally, compensation will include an amount not to exceed  
\$5,000.00 for travel and out-of-pocket expenses.
