A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE CENTRE
CITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION TO ACT ON BEHALF
OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY FOR CONSTRUCTION
OF A BUS SHELTER ON BROADWAY.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") has directed that the San Diego Transit bus stop at Horton Plaza Park be moved to the block between Second Avenue and Third Avenue on the south side of Broadway; and

WHEREAS, the Agency has entered into contracts for public improvements construction with Dyno Construction Company and L. R. Hubbard Construction Company for the extensive improvement of Broadway; and

WHEREAS, with the location of the new bus stop at the

frontage of the Central Savings Building there is a need for the delineation of and the shelter of bus passengers; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the Centre City Development Corporation is hereby authorized, on behalf of the Agency, to advertise and receive bids for the construction of a bus shelter and other street improvements on Broadway between Second and Third Avenues.
- 2. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or his designee, is hereby authorized to award the contract to the lowest responsible qualified bidder provided said bids are within the established budget for construction of the bus shelter.
- 3. That the expenditure shall not exceed \$85,000.00 from the Horton Plaza Redevelopment Project Fund for the construction of public improvements.
- 4. That the Centre City Development Corporation is hereby authorized, on behalf of the Agency, to administer said contract.
