REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO RESOLUTION NO. 999

ADOPTED ON SEPTEMBER 18, 1984

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") has entered into an agreement with VTN-San Diego so that improvements will be in place for the opening of Horton Plaza in August 1985; and

WHEREAS, Second Avenue and "G" Street and a location northerly of the intersection of "F" Street and Fourth Avenue require new signalization, including traffic signal controller panels. All other signalized intersections have existing panels and will only require certain conversion work which can be done by an electrical subcontractor; and

WHEREAS, funds for the purchase of two traffic control panels are provided in the Fiscal Year 1985 budget; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Centre City Development Corporation, Inc. is

hereby authorized, on behalf of the Agency, to advertise and

receive bids for purchase of traffic signal control boxes for the

Horton Plaza off-site improvements.

2. That the Executive Director of the Agency, or his

designee, is hereby authorized to award the contract to the

lowest qualified bidder, provided the bids are within the

established budget.

3. That the expenditure shall not exceed \$39,600.00 from the

Horton Plaza Redevelopment Project Fund for the purchase of said

traffic signal controllers.

4. That the Centre City Development Corporation, Inc. is

hereby authorized on behalf of the Agency to administer said

contract.
