and Development Agreement to provide all sewer, water and storm

drain lines to the perimeter of the property; and

WHEREAS, that portion of the perimeter street along "E"

Street does not have an adequate width to provide those utilities

in the public right-of-way due to the existence of other

utilities; and

WHEREAS, it is physically impossible to provide off-site

connections at this particular location; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of

San Diego, that payment to Horton Plaza Associates of \$25,699.00

for construction of sewer and storm drain collector systems as

indicated on Exhibit "A," is hereby authorized.
