A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING PAYMENT OF
\$25,699.00 TO HORTON PLAZA ASSOCIATES FOR
CONSTRUCTION OF SEWER AND STORM DRAIN
COLLECTOR SYSTEMS.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego
(the "Agency") is engaged in activities necessary to carry out
and implement the Redevelopment Plan for the Horton Plaza
Redevelopment Project; and

WHEREAS, in order to carry out and implement such
Redevelopment Plan, the Agency has heretofore entered into that
certain Disposition and Development Agreement dated August 25,
1981, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Agency is responsible through that Disposition

and Development Agreement to provide all sewer, water and storm drain lines to the perimeter of the property; and

WHEREAS, that portion of the perimeter street along "E" Street does not have an adequate width to provide those utilities in the public right-of-way due to the existence of other utilities; and

WHEREAS, it is physically impossible to provide off-site connections at this particular location; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, that payment to Horton Plaza Associates of \$25,699.00 for construction of sewer and storm drain collector systems as indicated on Exhibit "A," is hereby authorized.
