1. That 1,056 square feet located at the Senator, 119 West

"F" Street, is hereby approved as the site for the proposed

downtown marketing center.

2. That the Centre City Development Corporation, Inc. is

hereby authorized to enter into a 30-month lease, valued at

\$39,600.00 and commencing on November 1, 1984, for such premises.
