CAMERON BROS. CONSTRUCTION CO. FROM
\$204,044.42 TO \$258,115.55 IN THE HORTON PLAZA
REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") has entered into a Disposition and Development Agreement with Ernest W. Hahn, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, said Disposition and Development Agreement provides that the Agency will provide certain utility lateral lines for sewer, water and storm drain from the mains in the public street to the property line; and

WHEREAS, a public bidding process was utilized and through

that process, Cameron Bros. Construction Co. was selected as the lowest qualified bidder; and

WHEREAS, certain unforeseen problems have caused several change orders for work that was not anticipated in the initial bid by Cameron Bros. Construction Co.; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, that the amount of \$54,071.13 is hereby authorized to be added to the contract with Cameron Bros. Construction Co. for this project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the expenditure not to exceed \$343,200.00 from Fund No. 98400 was previously authorized on Resolution No. 945 adopted on June 26, 1984, A.C. No. 849063.
