ADOPTED ON JANUARY 8, 1985

A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF  
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO INCREASING THE  
AUTHORIZED EXPENDITURE FOR A PUBLIC WORKS  
CONTRACT WITH CAMERON BROS. CONST. CO., INC.,  
FROM \$123,727.00 TO \$148,225.00.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego  
(the "Agency") has entered into a Disposition and Development  
Agreement with Horton Plaza Associates; and

WHEREAS, said Disposition and Development Agreement provides  
that the Agency will provide adequate utility lines for sewer,  
water and storm drain in the project's vicinity; and

WHEREAS, a public bidding process was utilized and through  
that process, Cameron Bros. Const. Co., Inc. was selected as the  
lowest qualified bidder for the construction of a storm drain

line in "F" Street between First Avenue and Union Street and in  
First Avenue between "G" Street and Market Street; and

WHEREAS, certain unforeseen problems have caused a change  
order for work that was not anticipated in the initial bid by  
Cameron Bros. Const. Co., Inc.; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of  
San Diego, that the amount of \$24,498.00 is hereby added to the  
authorized expenditure for the contract with Cameron Bros. Const.  
Co., Inc. for this project; \$19,498.00 representing Change Order  
No. 1 and \$5,000.00 added for contingencies.
