(HA-86-17) HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO RESOLUTION NO. 00390 ADOPTED ON MAY 20, 1986

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NEED FOR AFFORDABLE SINGLE ROOM OCCUPANCY (SRO) ROOMS AND APPROVAL OF THE USE OF SUCH ROOMS.

WHEREAS, single room occupancy (SRO) hotel units traditionally house the City's lowest income households; and WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has documented the loss of 1,247 SRO hotel units since 1976; and

WHEREAS, a Housing Commission sponsored study has anticipated a decrease of approximately 953 additional SRO units; and

WHEREAS, the City Council on December 16, 1985, adopted an interim ordinance restricting for a period of one year the issuance of permits for the conversion and/or demolition of SRO hotels; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Housing Authority of The City of San Diego, that there is a need and a demand for affordable SRO rooms and that the Housing Authority approves the use of SRO rooms and approves, in concept, the use of federal housing subsidies to achieve affordability.
