RESOLUTION NO. 1152

ADOPTED ON JULY 23, 1985

A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO INCREASING THE
AUTHORIZED EXPENDITURE FOR A PUBLIC WORKS
CONTRACT WITH MUR-VIC CONSTRUCTION COMPANY,
INC. FROM \$280,736.50 TO \$292,551.50.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego
(the "Agency") has entered into a Disposition and Development
Agreement with Horton Plaza Associates (the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, said Agreement provides that the Agency will provide
adequate utility lines for sewer, water and storm drain in the
project's vicinity; and

WHEREAS, a public bidding process was utilized and through
that process, Mur-Vic Construction Company, Inc. was selected as
the lowest qualified bidder for the construction of utility

laterals in Fourth Avenue, G Street, First Avenue and E Street;
and

WHEREAS, final quantity calculations at the completion of the work identified more materials than were previously anticipated causing the budget to be exceeded; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, that the amount of \$11,815.00 is hereby added to the authorized expenditure for the contract with Mur-Vic Construction Company, Inc. for this project and the project is hereby completed.
