A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING AN AMENDMENT
TO THE AGREEMENT WITH O'MELVENY AND MYERS FOR
BOND COUNSEL SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego
(the "Agency") has entered into an agreement with O'Melveny and
Myers for bond counsel services for a maximum of \$97,500.00 in
connection with the sale of tax allocation bonds in the Columbia,
Marina and Horton Plaza Redevelopment Projects; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of
San Diego, that the Executive Director, or his designee, is
hereby authorized and empowered to accept and execute for and on
behalf of the Agency, an amendment to the letter agreement dated
April 17, 1984, with O'Melveny and Myers for bond counsel

services applying the unused balance of the original agreement toward services on the proposed subordinated tax allocation bonds in the Marina Redevelopment Project and modifying the rate structure as follows:
