## (RA-88-21) REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO RESOLUTION NO. 1536 ADOPTED ON SEPTEMBER 22, 1987

A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO, CALIFORNIA, CONSENTING TO A JOINT PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED FIFTH AMENDMENT TO THE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE MARINA REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION AND MAILING OF NOTICE OF SUCH JOINT PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego (the "Council") has heretofore adopted a Redevelopment Plan for the Marina Redevelopment Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") has prepared a proposed Fifth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Project, which proposed Fifth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan conforms to the requirements of the California Community Redevelopment Law (Health and Safety Code, Section 33000 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the California Community Redevelopment Law authorizes a joint public hearing on the proposed Fifth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan, with the consent of the Agency and the Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The Executive Director, or his designee, is hereby authorized and directed to transmit the proposed Fifth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Project to the Council.
- 2. The Agency hereby consents to a joint public hearing with the Council on the proposed Fifth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Project, and further, hereby, requests that the Council consent to a joint public hearing on the proposed Fifth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan.
- 3. The Agency hereby directs the Executive Director, or his designee, to set the date, time and place for the joint public

hearing on the proposed Fifth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan.

4. The Executive Director, or his designee, shall, in cooperation with the City Clerk of The City of San Diego, publish and mail notice of public hearing on the proposed Fifth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan, in the manner, and with other documents as required and established by law.
