A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO CONSENTING TO A JOINT PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED SIXTH AMENDMENT TO THE REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE COLUMBIA REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING PUBLICATION AND MAILING OF NOTICE OF SUCH JOINT PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, the City Council of The City of San Diego (the "Council") has heretofore adopted a Redevelopment Plan and a First, Second, Third, Fourth, and Fifth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Columbia Redevelopment Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") has prepared a proposed Sixth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Project, which proposed Sixth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan conforms to the requirements of the California Community Redevelopment Law (Health and Safety Code, Section 33000 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, the Agency has authorized and directed the Executive Director to submit the proposed Sixth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan to the Planning Commission of The City of San Diego, and to provide copies of the proposed Sixth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan to the property owners, residents and existing community organizations in the Project area; and

WHEREAS, the California Community Redevelopment Law authorizes a joint public hearing on the Sixth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan, with the consent of the Agency and the Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, as follows:

1. The Executive Director, or her designee, is hereby authorized and directed to transmit the proposed Sixth Amendment

to the Redevelopment Plan for the Project to the Council.

2. The Agency hereby consents to a joint public hearing with the Council on the proposed Sixth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan for the Project, and further, hereby requests that the Council consent to a joint public hearing on the proposed Sixth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan and establish the date, time and place therefor.

3. The Executive Director, or her designee, shall, in cooperation with the City Clerk of The City of San Diego, publish and mail notice of public hearing on the proposed Sixth Amendment to the Redevelopment Plan, in the manner, and with other documents as required and established by law.
