## (RA-89-96) THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO RESOLUTION NO. 1712 ADOPTED ON MARCH 20, 1989

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency for The City of San Diego entered into an agreement with the law firm of Kane, Ballmer & Berkman on August 3, 1988, for provision of legal services necessary for the planning and execution of redevelopment projects pursuant to the California Community Redevelopment Act; and,

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency is now in the process of forming new redevelopment projects for the Mid-City, North Park and San Diego University areas of The City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, these projects will require additional legal services not currently covered under the existing agreement with Kane, Ballmer & Berkman; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the Redevelopment Agency budgets for the Linda Vista and San Diego State University Foundation Projects are hereby amended by increases of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) and thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) respectively.
- 2. That a transfer from The City of San Diego of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) from Fund No. 18521 to Special Fund No. 98200, for the amendment to the Linda Vista Redevelopment Project, and thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) to Special Fund No. 98100, for the amendment to the San Diego State University Foundation Project, is hereby accepted.
- 3. That the Executive Director or her designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute for and on behalf of the Redevelopment Agency, an agreement with Kane, Ballmer & Berkman for special legal services for an amount not to exceed eighty-five thousand dollars (\$85,000), a copy of which is on file in the office of the secretary to the Redevelopment Agency as Document No. 1622.
- 4. That the City Auditor and Comptroller is hereby authorized to make expenditures not to exceed thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000) from Special Fund No. 98100, twelve

thousand five hundred dollars (\$12,500) from Special Fund No. 98200, twelve thousand five hundred dollars (\$12,500) from Special Fund No. 98300, and twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) from Special Fund 98500, for the above-described legal services.
