ADOPTED ON JULY 11, 1989

A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING PAYMENT TO
THE METROPOLITAN TRANSIT DEVELOPMENT BOARD FOR
REMOVAL AND RELOCATION OF UNUSED RAILROAD
TRACKAGE TO BE USED IN THE PROPOSED LINEAR
PARK, MARINA REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") has entered into a contract with Austin Hansen Fehlman and Peter Walker/Martha Schwartz for design of the Linear Park in the Marina Redevelopment Project area; and

WHEREAS, the design of this park utilizes the theme of transportation and incorporates railroad trackage into the overall design of the Park; and

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Transit Development Board has contracted with a contractor to remove the rails that are located only within the alignment of the Light Rail Trolley (LRT) tracks; and

WHEREAS, there is nearly a mile of railroad trackage that is within the park boundary but outside of the alignment of the LRT trackage and these tracks are intended to be used as a part of the Park; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, that the removal and storage of tracks by the Metropolitan Transit Development Board at a cost not to exceed \$56,760 is hereby authorized.
