A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE BASIC
CONCEPT/SCHEMATIC DRAWINGS WITH RESPECT TO THE
CONSTRUCTION OF THE OLD COLUMBIA SUITES WITHIN
THE COLUMBIA REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency"), is engaged in activities necessary to carry out and implement the Redevelopment Plan, for the Columbia Redevelopment Project (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, in order to carry out and implement such Redevelopment Plan, architectural drawings for a hotel building to be located at State and "B" Streets, have been prepared by the Developer, Sandor Shapery, and must be considered and approved or disapproved by the Redevelopment Agency;

WHEREAS, the Developer has submitted to the Agency the Basic Concept/Schematic Drawings pertaining to the development; and

WHEREAS, the Basic Concept/Schematic Drawings have been reviewed and recommended for approval by the Centre City Development Corporation, Inc. and the Planning Commission of The City of San Diego; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, that the Basic Concept/Schematic Drawings submitted by the Developer are hereby approved, subject to the conditions stated in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.
