ADOPTED ON FEBRUARY 6, 1990

A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO RECOMMENDING TO THE
PLANNING COMMISSION THE APPROVAL OF THE
AMENDED PRELIMINARY REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE
MID-CITY REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Council of The City of San Diego (the "Council")
has, by resolution, designated a Survey Area for the Mid-City
Redevelopment Project; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission of The City of San Diego
(the "Commission") shall select the Mid-City Redevelopment
Project Area boundaries; and

WHEREAS, upon such selection, the Commission, in accordance
with the California Community Redevelopment Law (Health and
Safety Code sections 33000, et seq.) shall formulate a
Preliminary Redevelopment Plan for the Mid-City Redevelopment
Project; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency on October 30, 1989,
recommended to the Planning Commission adoption of the Mid-City
Preliminary Plan; and

WHEREAS, the recommended Mid-City Preliminary Redevelopment
Plan has been amended; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of
San Diego, that the Redevelopment Agency hereby recommends to the
Commission that it formulate and adopt as the Mid-City
Redevelopment Project, the proposed Preliminary Redevelopment
Plan for Mid-City Redevelopment Project on file in the office of
the Secretary of the Redevelopment Agency as Document No. 1715.
