ADOPTED ON FEBRUARY 20, 1990

A RESOLUTION OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AMENDING THE BUDGET AND AUTHORIZING THE CENTRE CITY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION TO ACT ON BEHALF OF THE AGENCY FOR THE FABRICATION AND CONSTRUCTION OF TWO IDENTIFICATION SIGNS IN THE MARINA REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego (the "Agency") has determined that it should encourage development in the Marina Redevelopment Project area pursuant to the adopted plan; and

WHEREAS, the Agency has a desire to identify its intent to construct a linear park along the southern portion of the Marina Redevelopment Project area; and

WHEREAS, the Corporation on behalf of the Agency and pursuant to Resolution No. 1793 did receive bids for the fabrication and installation of said signs; and

WHEREAS, the budget as authorized by the Agency was insufficient; and

WHEREAS, it is now appropriate to provide identification signs for this area; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, that:

1. The Agency hereby authorizes an increase to the budget of \$10,273 for a total budget of \$30,273.

2. The Agency hereby authorizes the Executive Director of the Agency (or his designee) to award the contract to A.L. Wylie Company.

3. The expenditure shall not exceed \$30,273 from the Marina Redevelopment Project; and

4. The Agency hereby authorizes the Centre City Development Corporation to administer said contract.
