REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF  
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO  
RESOLUTION NO. 1843  
ADOPTED ON MARCH 20, 1990

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, as part of its efforts to redevelop the Centre City has encountered problems with contaminated soils and groundwater; and

WHEREAS, in order to remove the contaminants and recover costs, certain statutes of State law must be clarified and/or changed; and

WHEREAS, legislation has been proposed to permit redevelopment agencies to remove the contaminants and recover costs; and

WHEREAS, to assist in the passage of legislation, it is necessary to obtain legislative advocacy services to the State Legislature; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Redevelopment Agency of The City of San Diego, that the Executive Director, or his designee, is hereby authorized and empowered to execute for and on behalf of the Agency an agreement with Rees and Associates, Inc., for legislative advocacy services at a cost not to exceed \$10,000.00. A copy of said Agreement is on file in the office of the Secretary to the Agency as Document No. 1722.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the expenditure in an amount not to exceed \$10,000.00 from the Marina Redevelopment Project, Fund No. 98395 for this agreement is hereby authorized and approved.
